TO : ALL CONCERNED
SUBJECT : Monitoring and Reporting on the Status of Filipino Workers in Japan

To further strengthen our protection to our OFWs who may be affected by the launching by North Korea of a missile traversing the airspace of Japan, all agencies which have deployed workers to Japan are hereby directed to accomplish the attached Monitoring form containing the following details:

1. Inventory/list of all recruited workers, including exact location, contact numbers, information on their respective employers with contact numbers/addresses;
2. Status report on the condition/situation of their deployed workers onsite


Agencies are further directed to regularly coordinate with their respective employers, closely monitor the condition of their deployed workers onsite, and to prepare contingency plans in the case of escalation of tensions in Japan.

Monitoring reports shall be submitted to the POEA Pre-Employment Service Office at marketdev@poea.gov.ph every Thursday of the week or immediately as may be necessary.

Non-compliance shall be dealt with in accordance to applicable provisions of the Revised POEA Rules and Regulations Governing the Recruitment and Employment of Landbased Overseas Filipino Workers of 2016 as well as the Revised POEA Rules and Regulations Governing the Recruitment and Employment of Filipino Seafarers of 2016.
