

**SUBJECT** 

Deployment of Stranded OFWs

Overseas Filipino workers who were supposed to leave for their respective job sites were stranded at the Ninoy Aquino International Airport with the cancellation of international flights following the crash landing on August 16 of a Xiamen Air Boeing 737-800. Some workers expressed fear they might lose their jobs if they don't reach their destinations on time.

In this regard and to ensure that contractual obligations are observed, all recruitment agencies with workers booked for flights from August 17 to 20, 2018 are advised to inform their employers that the delay in deployment was not on their account or not the worker's fault but due to the Xiamen Air mishap.
