Concerned EPS workers must undergo medical examination only from accredited clinics and to secure their medical certification. They are instructed to report immediately to the Recruitment & Documentation Division, Government Placement Branch, Ground floor POEA for submission of their valid medical (Pre-employment medical exam and tuberculosis test) and training certificates, passport and other documentary requirements. **The Korean Embassy has issued an instruction on the need to submit the NBI Clearance, valid for three (3) months from date of issuance when applying for a Korean visa.**

Please be advised that **ninety one (91) EPS workers** were denied entry to Korea and sent back to the Philippines on that same day due to passport forgery.
