Please log on to www.poea.gov.ph for the complete list of licensed PRAs from which your employer may choose from: (ONLINE SERVICES → VERIFICATION OF AGENCY'S JOB ORDERS → SEARCH AVAILABLE JOB ORDERS BY COUNTRY → "SORT BY AGENCY" → SELECT COUNTRY OF DESTINATION → SUBMIT.

However, Domestic Workers and Live-in Caregivers whose age falls below the minimum age requirement (23 years old) as provided for by Governing Board Resolution No. 04, Series of 2006 cannot be cleared for deployment due to aforesaid reason.
