



EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES IN SINGAPORE FOR FILIPINO HOTEL AND CASINO WORKERS

The Philippine Overseas Labor Office (POLO) in Singapore reported that the Singapore government had approved the construction of two integrated resorts with casino. The two projects are estimated to boost investment in Singapore by S\$5 billion and create 35,000 jobs that will be open for both local and foreign workers. According to Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong, going ahead with these projects would place Singapore a step closer towards achieving its goal of becoming a cosmopolitan hub in the region. The two resorts are expected to be operational by 2009.

The POLO believes that Filipino workers, particularly in the hotel and gaming industry and entertainment, stand a good chance of securing employment in the island state once these projects are completed.
