



JOB OPENINGS AT WYNN RESORTS (MACAU)

The Philippine Overseas Labor Office (POLO) in Macau has reported that Wynn Resorts (Macau), an affiliate of Wynn Resorts (USA), will recruit more than 4,000 employees for over 500 positions for its project in Nape in time for its opening in 2006. Positions cover different levels from managerial to operational in all departments of the casino-hotel resort.

In view of Macau's localization program, local residents are given priority in the recruitment, particularly those who are qualified for basic level jobs. However, mid level and supervisory positions in the executive, finance, gaming, hotel, human resources, information technology and marketing departments are open for foreign workers, due to the territory's lack of skilled workers and limited manpower pool.

Wynn Resorts (Macau) has set up a 2,000 square meter fully computerized recruitment center at China City Plaza in Nape. The process of application will run for 15 weeks until the end of February next year and will be followed by interviews, selection and job placements.
