MFO 1: Overseas Employees Welfare Services

a. Number of workers monitored

For the 1st Quarter 2017, there are about 427,672 deployed overseas Filipino workers consisting of the following: *Preliminary deployment data.*

-Rehires	=	265,902

b. Number of overseas Filipino workers provided with assistance

A total of 2,784 OFWs were provided with assistance acted upon within prescribed period.

MFO 2: Overseas Employment Regulation Service

a. Number of license, registration and accreditation applications acted upon

10,428 applications for license, registration and accreditation were acted upon for Y2016.

b. Number of overseas Filipino workers contracts reviewed

644,228 OFW contracts were reviewed and processed for y2016 consisting of the following: *Preliminary data.*

c. Percentage of applications processed within five days

100% of applications for renewal of license were processed within five days or a total of 59 applications.

d. Number of inspections and assessments undertaken

360 inspections and assessments were undertaken for the 1st quarter 2017.

e. Percentage of inspections that result in one or more detected violations

0.60% or 2 out of 360 inspections resulted in one or more detected violations of licensed agencies.

f. Number of enforcement cases undertaken (Signed Orders)

6 writs of execution signed.

g. Percentage of enforcement cases that result in a favorable judgment

100% or 6 enforcement of cases resulted in favorable judgment

h. Percentage of enforcement cases resolved within 90 days

100% or 6 enforcement of cases were resolved within 90 days.
