**Non - Requirement of Visa Stamping for Work Visa
at the Embassy of the State of Qatar in Manila**

The public is hereby informed that the Embassy of the State of Qatar shall no longer require visa stamping for work visas effective 15 November 2019. Instead, print-out copies of the electronic visa issued by the Ministry of Interior will be sufficient and valid for presentation to the airport and immigration authorities and other concerned government entities. Attached is a sample of the electronic visa print-out for reference.

The Embassy, however, emphasizes the following:

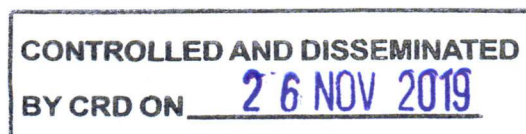
1. The "no visa stamping" procedure is only for work visas. Embassy procedures and policies for other types of visa remain to be in effect;
2. In instances where work visas may still be stamped on passports even after 15 November 2019, such visas are considered valid and should be honored by concerned authorities; and
3. For returning workers and those with Family visa status, the Qatar National ID (QID) will serve as a valid document to re-enter Qatar as long as they do not exceed 6-months stay outside Qatar.
