Singapore Extends Partial Lockdown

Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loon, in a public address last 21 April 2020, announced the extension by four (4) weeks of a partial lockdown in Singapore to last until 01 June 2020. In order to curb the resurging spread of Covid-19 in the city-state, measures of the partial lockdown include the closure of most workplaces and schools.

The Prime Minister notes the cooperation of migrant workers during this difficult period and assures them of the government's protection of their health, welfare and livelihood.
