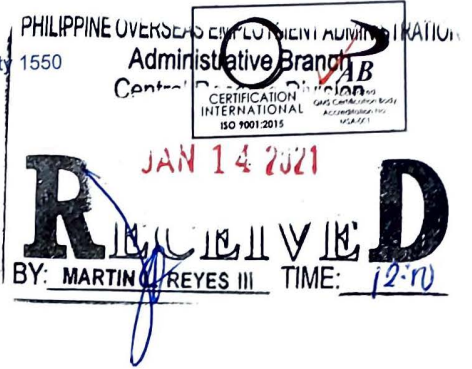

Minimum Wage in Taiwan for 2021

The Ministry of Labor of Taiwan has announced that starting 01 January 2021, the minimum wage per month will increase from NT\$23,800 to NT\$24,000, and the hourly salary will increase from NT\$158 to NT\$160.

The basic wage legislation in Taiwan is aimed at safeguarding the basic life of workers and maintaining their necessary purchasing power. The Ministry directs that all institutions where the current wages have not reached the adjusted amount before the year opening shall be increased, and wage levels for monthly paid workers shall not be less than NT\$24,000. Workers who are paid on an hourly basis shall receive no less than NT\$160 per hour, and the daily wages of those who are paid daily shall not be less than NT\$160 multiplied by the amount of working hours within the statutory working hours. The new minimum wage shall be used as the basis in calculating overtime pay of workers.
