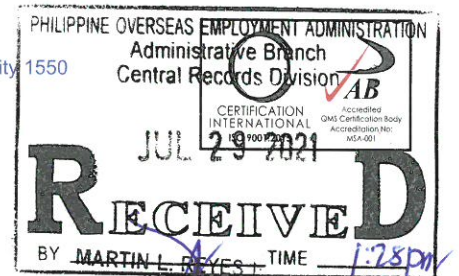

IRELAND REMOVES THE PHILIPPINES FROM THE MANDATORY HOTEL QUARANTINE REQUIREMENT

The Government of Ireland announced the removal of 34 countries from the mandatory hotel quarantine list including the Philippines, starting on 16 July 2021.

Under the mandatory hotel quarantine system, any person who had been in a designated State within 14 days of arriving in Ireland must pre-book accommodation in a designated quarantine facility and present for quarantine on arrival.

Ireland's Minister for Health Stephen Donnelly TD has announced that while 34 countries have been removed from the said list, Cuba will be added to the list of designated states for mandatory hotel quarantine. The move relating to Cuba also covers people arriving in Ireland who have transited through the country in the previous 14 days.
